

## Fairview Tuesday League

In addition to the **Tuesday League** rules, it is the opinion of the **Committee** that a rules reminder/explanation may be in order. There may be some “new” golfers, as well as some “old” golfers, that are not familiar with the following:

*“Players are required to play with another **League** member for score verification\*...players not playing with another **League** member (for score verification) will not be eligible for weekly prizes.”*

### **In other words...**

- > It is the responsibility of each player to count his/her own strokes, as well as those of the other players in the group.
- > Score cards for the group are to be signed by the player keeping score, as well as another person in the group attesting the scores. Any scoring discrepancy should be resolved prior to signing the card. Once signed by both players, the scores become official.

### **Also...**

The **Committee** realizes that not everyone is of equal ability. Some players take longer to play a shot/hole than others. We would ask, however, that all players make an effort to maintain pace of play. Play “ready” golf. If you determine that your group is holding up play, please allow faster players to play through.

### **Finally...**

The **League** rules allow you to “stir” the ball. Once you have “stirred” the ball any stroke taken must be counted. Whether it goes 200 yards, 2 inches, or you miss it altogether...it’s a stroke and it counts.

\*This is now a **USGA** rule. Scores shot while playing alone are no longer eligible to be entered for handicap consideration.
